
MY FIRST THREE MONTHS...

COMMMUNITY NEEDING HOPE – Outside of our church walls are families struggling to get by. Some of them have been receiving monthly Food cards.

NEEDS – Form a new ministry that would continue to offer hope and assistance to these families.

ONLINE COMMUNITY- We are gathering a new community of visitors watching our online messages. These people have never attended our church.

NEEDS- An online website that would offer them an online church experience. Providing a Message, music, small group, prayer, discipleship, etc.

ONLINE CHURCH COMMUNITY- We have about half of our church watching sermons online. And about an 1/8 are trying new technology like ZOOM and Tithley giving.

NEEDS- Education in using online applications to connect them better to church. Finding ways to encourage them to try small groups and bible studies by zoom.

CHURCH COMMUNITY NOT ONLINE

– We have about ¼ of the church that nas no interest in new technology. Some of these members have little or no internet. Some are SHUT-INS. Many of them are just waiting for things to be normal again.

NEEDS – Finding ways to connect with them without internet. Providing Newsletters, sermons on DVD, Hymns and music CDs. Porch visits, calls, cards, emails, etc.
